

Dear Parents/Carers,

Please see attached information regarding your child's return to school during the week commencing 22.2.21. While we await further communication from Welsh Government and the Local Authority, we felt it important to let you know as soon as possible the plans that we have made for your children's return to school. The following provides information on the timings of the school day, the point for drop-off/collection and the days which your child will be attending school.

Your child's class teacher will inform you which days your child will be in school. Please make every effort to arrive at the given time. Arriving too early may cause congestion on site and too late will mean that your child misses the important welcome back and checking-in that will take place when all pupils are in class. If your child has been attending the hub provision they may continue to do so if there are no other arrangements for safe supervision at home. However, as staff return to their classroom duties there will now be a very limited number of children who we can take and KS2 pupils will be prioritised. From Monday 1st March all Foundation Phase pupils will return to full days. During the first week back there will be no online learning in addition to the days your child attends the school setting. Therefore, there will be two days of school-based learning for each child, but no expectation that work is also completed at home. Staff will be very much focused on the pupils who attend school each day. You are reminded that face coverings must be worn when attending the school site and every effort must be made to socially distance. There is no requirement for pupils to wear face coverings. There will only be breakfast club for pupils attending the hub during the first week back; bookings will need to be made with Mrs Thomas as normal. We are very much looking to welcoming the children back to school. In the meantime, stay safe and enjoy the half-term break – with no home schooling!
