### Reminders

### Social Media

It has been brought to our attention that some pupils here are accessing social media sites which are out of their recommended legal age limit. We know that social media services are popular with young people of all ages. Parents have an important role in helping prepare their children to go online before they start to use social media platforms, discussing the type of appropriate language to be used and who they should be talking to. Together you can look at the key things they need to know about staying safe online, critical thinking, and the safety settings that are available to them. It is the responsibility of parents to monitor what their child posts on social media when they are under the age limit. Here at school we continually promote e-safety and this is reinforced by PC Thomas during her cyber-safety presentations. Currently, the minimum age to open an account on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Discord, Pinterest, TikTok and Snapchat is 13. YouTube requires account holders to be 18, however a 13-year-old can sign up with a parent's permission. If you find out your child has joined a social media service without your permission, try to discuss it with them; find out why they signed up and explain your concerns and how they can stay safe.
