Topic

Our first topic is "Cymru Cyffrous". During this topic the children have chosen to explore: our local area, Wildlife found in Wales, the Celts and Welsh culture. We will be investigating our topic across the curriculum; incorporating and consolidating Numeracy, Literacy and ICT skills.

Literacy

This term we will be reading and writing:

Fiction: Stories.

Non- Fiction: Instruction text.

Our first class novel will be George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl.

Individual readers will be listened to daily so please ensure reading books are in school every day.

Numeracy

Numeracy topics for this term include: developing understanding of place value, money skills, checking strategies, problem solving, length, time, right angles and lines of symmetry.

There will be many opportunities for the children to apply these skills to their work across the curriculum.

Pupils are encouraged to practise multiplication tables (2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 10) to support their problem solving in the classroom.

Cymraeg

During our Welsh sessions, we will be learning about Dewi Sant. The children will be developing their Welsh language skills through oracy, reading and writing activities. We will be learning a variety of sentence patterns to talk about a person.

Religious Education

The children will be exploring the following themes through our Come and See scheme:

Homes: God's vision for every family.

Promises: Promises made at Baptism.

Judaism: Synagogue.

Visitors: Waiting for the coming of Jesus.
